

# RAJASTHAN ENGINEERING ADMISSION PROCESS (REAP)-2021

## Admission in first year of B.E. / B.Tech. and B.Arch. courses

### Session 2021-22

As per the directions received from Chairman SLC REAP-2021, Following changes has been made in the general instructions and procedures related with admission in first year of B.E. / B.Tech. and B.Arch. courses for session 2021-22.

#### Revision No. 1:- Admission in B.E./B.Tech. and B.Arch. courses under out of state quota:-

Candidates who belong to any State other than Rajasthan shall be considered for admission in first year of B.E./B.Tech. and B.Arch. courses. Admission against 15% seats of AICTE total approved intake are available for such candidates which belong to any State other than Rajasthan. (For admission in private engineering institutions and self-financed category in the Autonomous Engineering Colleges of Govt. of Rajasthan).

If seats remain vacant (Unfilled) after completion of admission in this round (including upward movement of eligible candidates) the vacant seats will be merged in open category for Rajasthan state candidates in next rounds.

#### Revision No. 2:- Changes in Priorities of Admission for B.E./B.Tech. Courses:-

The priorities given earlier in general instructions and procedures booklet for REAP-2021 at point no. 2.7.1 was as under:-

2	Percentile obtained in class 12 <sup>th</sup> and having Physics & Mathematic subjects.	2 <sup>nd</sup>
3	Percentile obtained in class 12 <sup>th</sup> and having Physics or Mathematic subjects.	3 <sup>rd</sup>
4	Percentage obtained in Diploma in Engineering & Technology approved by state government.	4 <sup>th</sup>

3	Percentile obtained in class 12 <sup>th</sup> and having Physics or Mathematic subjects.	3 <sup>rd</sup>
4	Percentage obtained in Diploma in Engineering & Technology approved by state government.	4 <sup>th</sup>
